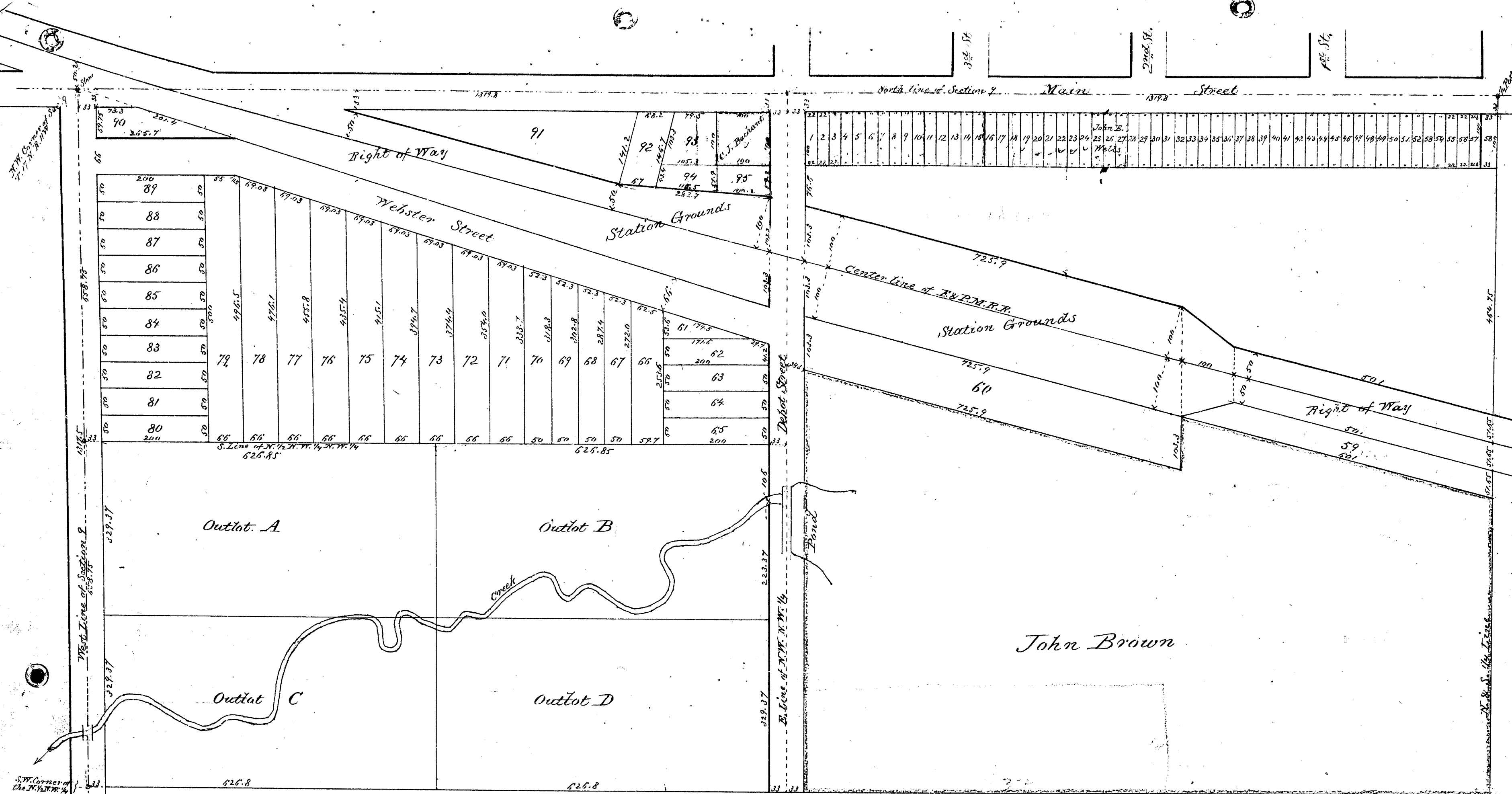
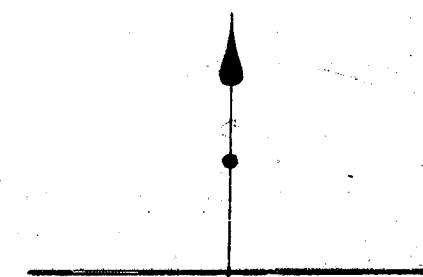

Crary, Trustees, owners and by Harrison Cary as Surveyor for the purpose of being recorded as a Town Plat, in accordance with the Statute. The lands marked "Right of Way" and "Station Grounds" are owned by the Flint and Pere Marquette Rail Road Company. Lands previously conveyed by metes and bounds are plateted with the name of the grantee thereon.

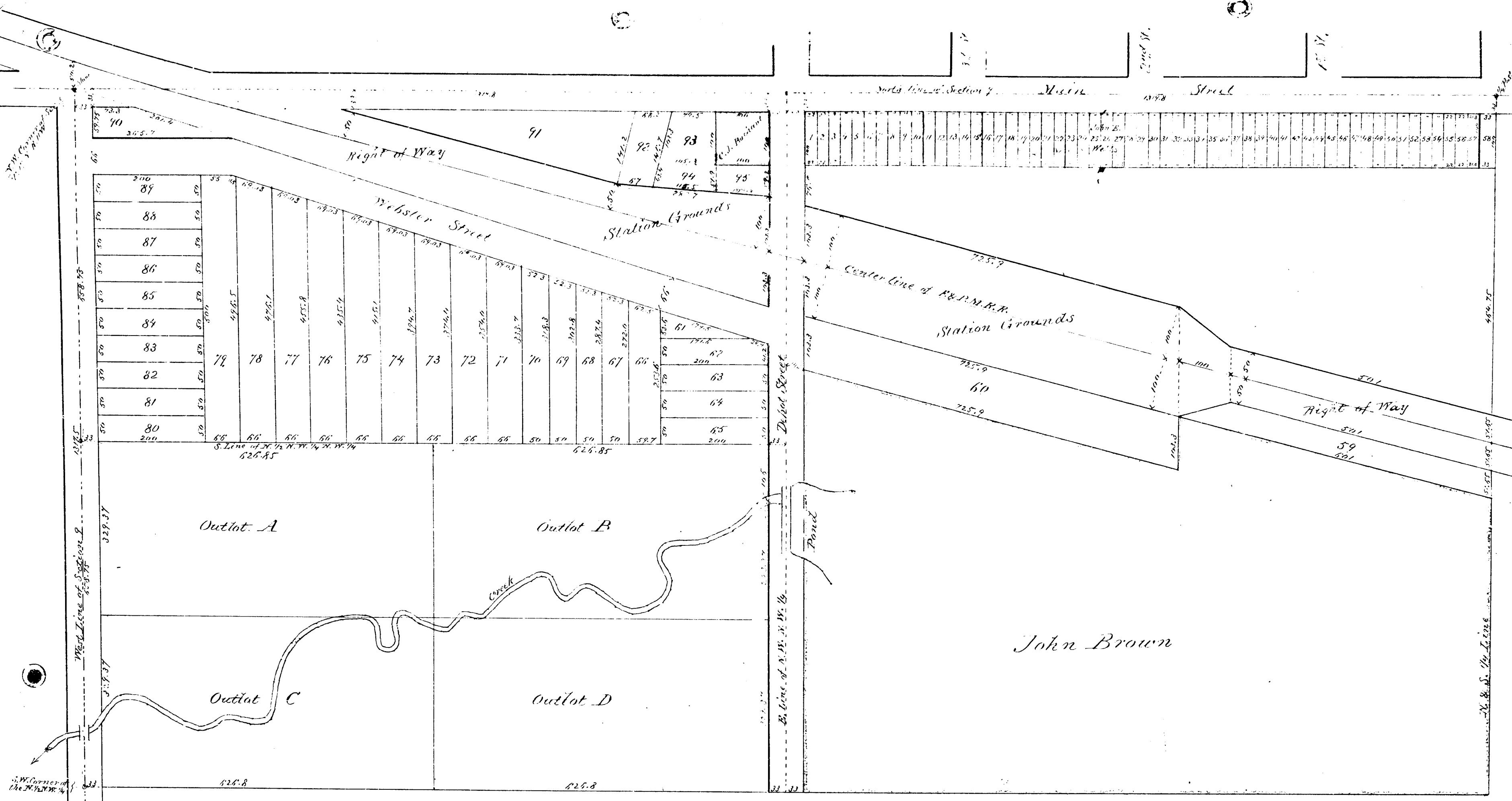
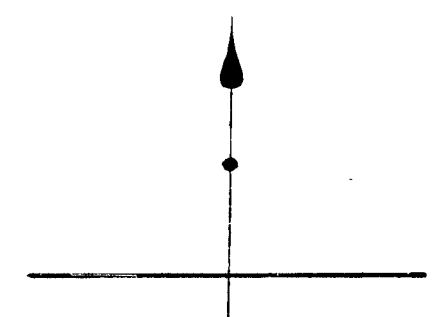
