



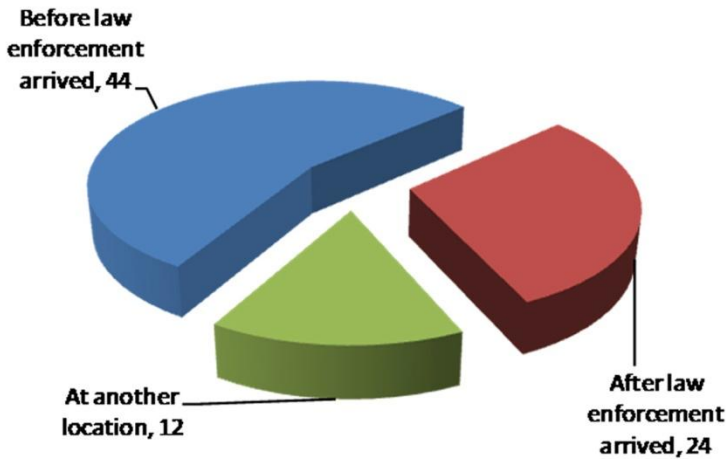
ACTIVE SHOOTER INCIDENTS

Shooter Suicides

The FBI identified 200 active shooter incidents involving 205 shooters in the U.S. that occurred between 2000 and 2015.

Quick Look:

Shooter Outcomes



80 (39%) of the shooters chose to self-terminate via gun shot wounds, making suicide the most common shooter outcome.

- Male: 77
- Female: 3

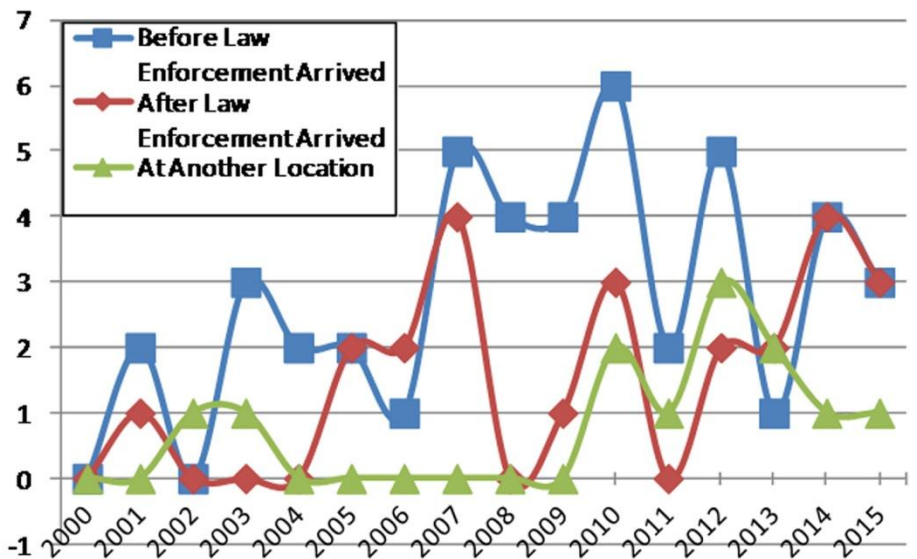
Key Findings:

In 2015, the rate of shooters committing suicide:

Before law enforcement arrived on scene decreased by 1.

After law enforcement arrived on scene decreased by 1.

At another location stabilized at 1.
