




ACTIVE SHOOTER INCIDENTS

Law Enforcement Engagement

The FBI identified 200 active shooter incidents involving 205 shooters in the U.S. that occurred between 2000 and 2015.

Quick Look:



Key Findings:

- Law enforcement engagement with the shooter to end the threat: 61 incidents
- Increase in recent years:
 - Highest number of incidents: 9 (2013)
 - Number of incidents stabilized in 2014 and 2015: 8 each
- Incidents involving multiple shooters: 2
- Law enforcement casualties: 39
 - Killed: 12
 - Wounded: 27
