Honorable Members of the Lake County Board of Commissioners,
The Lake County Equalization Department has prepared this report on your behalf, pursuant to Michigan Compiled Law (MCL) Section 211.37. Apportionment is statutorily required to be completed annually in the month of October.

This report presents a summary of the recommended tax rates within Lake County. Every tax rate request of the County, Townships, Villages, local School Districts, Intermediate School Districts, Library Districts and other authorized levying authorities, were analyzed.

Statutory responsibility of County Board of Commissioners is contained in Sec. 37 of the General Property Tax Law, P.A. 206 of 1983 as amended, Section 211.1 through 211.157.

Sec. 37. County Board of Commissioners, at its annual session in October of each year, shall ascertain and determine the amount of money to be raised for county purposes, and shall apportion the amount, and also the amount of state tax and indebtedness of the county to the state among the townships in the county in proportion to the valuation of the taxable real and personal property as determined by this board, or as determined by the state tax commission upon appeal, in the manner provided by law, which determination and apportionment shall be entered in large on county records. The board shall also examine all certificates, statements, papers, and records submitted to it, showing the money to be raised in the several townships for school, highway, drain, township, and other purposes. It shall hear and duly consider all objections made to raising that money by any taxpayer affected. If it appears to the board that any certificate, statement, paper, or record is not properly certified or is in anyway defective, or that any proceeding to authorize the raising of the money has not been had or is in anyway imperfect, the board shall verify the same, and if the certificate, statement, paper, record, or proceeding can then be corrected, supplied, or had, the board shall authorize and require the defects or omissions of proceedings to be corrected, supplied, or had. The board may refer any or all the certificates, statements, papers, records, and proceedings to the prosecuting attorney, who shall investigate and without delay report in writing his or her opinion to the board. The board shall direct that the money proposed to be raised for township, school, highway, drain, and all other purposes as authorized by law, shall be spread upon the assessment roll of the proper townships. This action and direction shall be entered in full upon the records of the proceedings of the board, and shall be final as to the levy and assessment of all the taxes, except if there is a change made in the equalization of any county by the state tax commission upon appeal in the manner provided by law. The direction for spread of taxes shall be expressed in terms of millage's to be spread against the taxable values of properties and shall not direct the raising of any specific amount of money. This section does not apply when section 36(2) 1 applies. Amended by P.A. 1994, No. 415, Sub. Sec. I, Eff. Dec. 29, 1994.

L-4029 Tax Rate Request Forms have been reviewed for the County Board of Commissioners, millage rollbacks, allocations, and voter authorizations have been evaluated to verify the levies are correct.

MCL Sec. 211.37 allows the County Board of Commissioners to ask the County Prosecutor to investigate any questions concerning any millage levy and give the Board a written opinion.

The State reported taxable values for Special Acts parcels, Act 198 Industrial Facilities Exemptions and Act 255 Commercial Facilities Exemptions, are not included in the taxable values for the Apportionment Report.

I respectfully request that you move to adopt the following motion:

Move to adopt the L-4402 Statement showing taxable valuations and mills apportioned by the Lake County Board of Commissioners for the year 2023 and authorize Casey Guthrie, Lake County Equalization Director, to sign the L-4402, thereby authorizing and directing the various assessing officers to spread the rates against the taxable valuations for 2023.

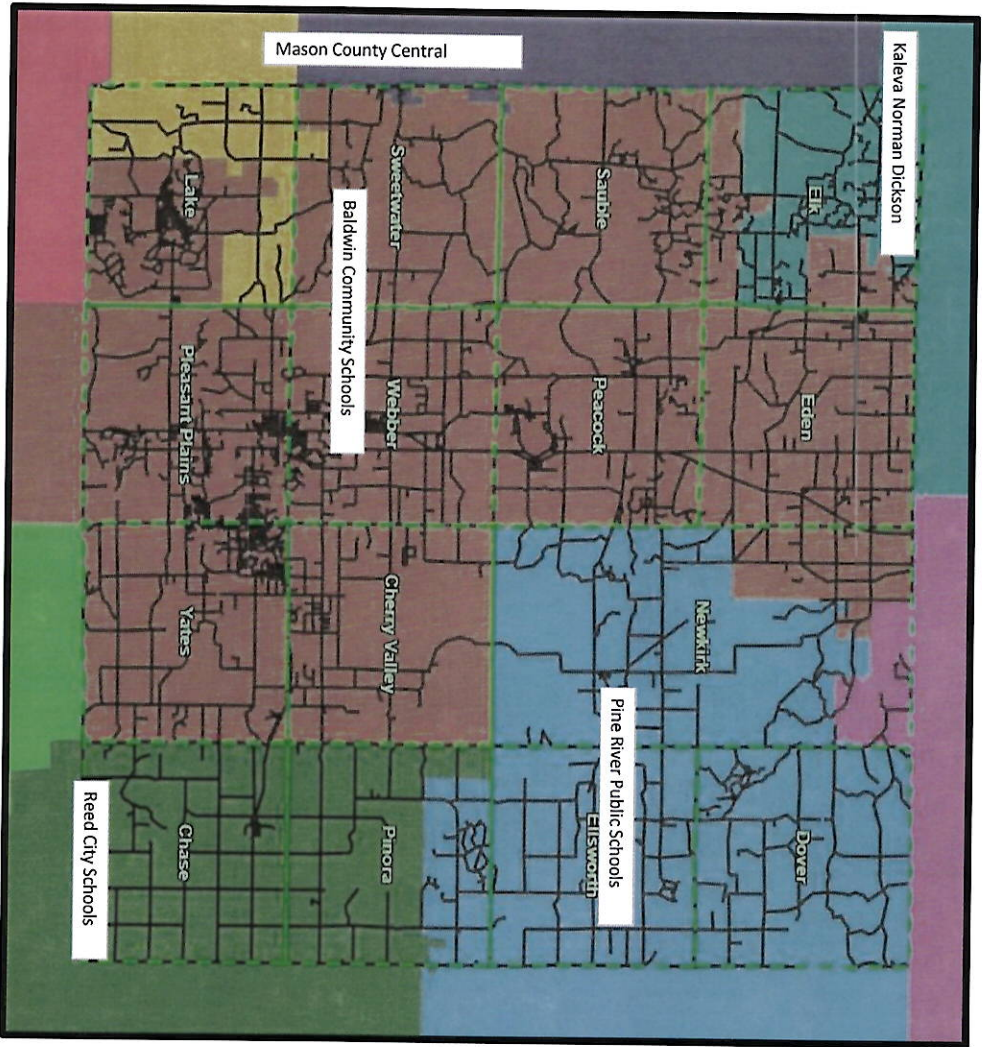




